- 1. You <u>must</u> have a judgment not to exceed \$15,000.00 against an individual or an entity before you file an Affidavit of Garnishment <u>and</u> the Garnishee <u>must</u> be located in Mitchell County. A copy of the judgment (FIFA) <u>must</u> be attached to the Affidavit of Garnishment.
- Once you have obtained a judgment against the defendant, you must decide which type of garnishment to file:
 Affidavit of Continuing Garnishment for wages: may be filed only where and Employer/Employee relationship exists between the garnishee and the defendant.

Please choose the correct affidavit and summons a pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 18-4-7(d). If the Plaintiff chooses the incorrect form of summons of garnishment of any type, the garnishment shall be invalid and the garnishee shall be released of all liability.

- 3. The costs of filing a garnishment in this Court is \$95.00. This includes all filing fees and service of the garnishment on the Garnishee.
- 4. You will need the following forms to file with the Court:

An original and 1 service copy of the Affidavit of Garnishment

An original and 1 service copy of the Summons of Garnishment

1 copy of the Notice to Defendant of Right Against Garnishment of Money, Including Wages and Other Property and Defendant's Claim Form

1 copy of the Georgia Garnishment Exemptions

1 copy of the judgment (FIFA)

The Court will retain all originals and serve the garnishee with the service copy. You will need to make a copy of all forms to serve on the Defendant as required in O.C.G.A. § 18-4-8(b). Please speak with a Deputy Clerk to obtain forms.

- 5. The total amount of the garnishment can include the amounts that you were awarded in your judgment, any interest and court costs you may be entitled. This amount cannot exceed \$15,000.00. The Affidavit of Garnishment must be notarized.
- 6. Pursuant to O.C.G.A. 18-4-8(b), the Plaintiff <u>must</u> serve the Defendant with a copy of the Affidavit of Garnishment, the Summons of Garnishment, and the Notice to Defendant of Right Against Garnishment of Money, Including Wages and Other Property, Defendant's Claim Form and Georgia Garnishment Exemptions. The Defendant must be served within the time of filing the affidavit and three (3) business days after the service of the garnishment on the Garnishee. If the Defendant is not served within this time period the garnishment may be dismissed. If the <u>Defendant</u> is a resident of Mitchell County and you want the Deputy to serve him/her with his/her copy of the garnishment, please add an additional \$50.00 to the cost.
- 7. Please file a Certificate of Service with appropriate service checked, along with all required documents with the Court. Plaintiff's obligation to provide notice of the garnishment to the Defendant is governed by O.C.G.A. § 18-4-8. Please read this code section if you are unfamiliar with garnishment law regarding notice to the Defendant.
- 8. Please file a Plaintiff's Application for Disbursement of Funds. If the Court receives funds from the Garnishee, the funds will be disbursed according to the law in a timely manner. The <u>Court will not disburse any funds until the Disbursement of Funds is received.</u> The Court must receive documentation that the Defendant has been served with the garnishment before any funds will be disbursed.

INSTRUCTIONS TO GARNISHEE FOR ANSWERING A CONTINUING GARNSIHMENT

Please review the revised law governing garnishments in O.C.G.A. 18-4—et.al. effective May 12,2016 as there are new requirements of the garnishee. Please consult with an attorney if you need legal advice. The court is prohibited by law from providing legal advice to any party.

O.C.G.A. 18-4-4 provides the methods in which to determine the amount of money to deduct from the defendant's wages. These methods should be used on all Continuing Garnishments except Garnishments for alimony and child support. The law requires that the lesser of the two amounts be deducted from the Defendant's wages and sent to the Court, along with a completed garnishee answer form.

Method 1: 25% of the net disposable earnings for the period.

Method 2: The amount of disposable earnings which exceeds the 30 times the minimum wage. (Minimum

Wage of \$7.50 X 30)

Example for the wages paid per week.

\$290.00 Employees gross pay for the period __\$41.19 Taxes withheld \$248.81 Net Disposable Earnings

Method 1: \$248.81 X 25% = \$62.20 Method 2: \$248.81 - \$217.00 = \$31.81

Since \$31.81 is the lesser of the two figures, this is the amount that should be sent to the Court.

Please remit a completed garnishee answer to the Court along with the check each time you file an answer. Please send a copy of the garnishee answer to the Plaintiff and Defendant. Please complete a certificate of service indicating you have provided a copy of the garnishee answer to both parties and file it with the Court.

Pursuant to O.C.G.A. 18-4-13 the garnishee shall provide the Defendant with the Notice to Defendant of Right Against Garnishment Money, including wages and other property, Defendant's claim form, and Georgia Garnishment Exemptions as provided by Plaintiff in the service copy.
