Scope and Quantities of Work:

The Work of this project consists of grading, laying base, and paving a 22' wide ditch section road over Lake Pleasant Church Road in Mitchell County. Lake Pleasant Church Road is an existing dirt road that is 3.64 miles long. Estimated quantities for the above-mentioned work will include 49,240 SY of 6" Soil Cement Base, 6,477 TONS of 2.5" Asphalt in two lifts, 3,447 Gal of Tack, 2,202 LF of Storm Pipes, End Sections, Grading Complete, Traffic Control, NPDES Measures, Erosion and Sediment Control BMP's, Driveways, Striping, Relocating Mailboxes, Installing New Signs, Clearing and Grubbing, and various other related accessories and appurtenances as shown on the Drawings and called for in the Contract Documents.

Bids shall be on a unit price basis with lump sum prices for certain items of the Work.
