The Flint River

The Mitchell County Pro Tennis Invitational, a four-day charity tennis event, is another attraction you wouldn't want to miss. One of the highlights of the senior pro tour each year, this tournament is the most famous tennis event of its kind in Georgia and probably the United States and has attracted over two dozen touring professionals for over twenty-five years.

Looking for somewhere to just get away for a night or a weekend? Camilla boasts two Bed & Breakfasts; Eagle Eyrie and McRee Hall. Staying at these two historic properties are a must. Although primarily a bed & breakfast, Tall Pines Inn Bed & Breakfast, located in Pelham, is ideal for meetings or reunions. Pelham is home to many historic landmarks, one being the Hand Trading Company Building. Built in 1916, this four story replica of the Marshall Field's Department Store in Chicago, Illinois, has been described as the "Big Store in a Country Town." Also in Pelham, the Wildlife Festival held every year, is growing bigger and better along with the Auction for the Arts. The Pelham County Jamboree is held every Saturday night with musicians from around the area playing a variety of music. Come and bring your "pickin' instrument". All of these events entice visitors to Camilla and Pelham, as well as the many historic sites located within the County like the Jackson -Davis House, the Flint River, and scenic plantations.

Speaking of plantations, this area is also home to some of the best quail hunting plantations around the South. These plantations offer a relaxing time outdoors while enjoying a picturesque scene. Some of the local plantations have overnight accommodations ranging from rustic hunting lodges to unique cabins overlooking the Flint River. Every year, many avid outdoorsmen and fishermen enjoy the Flint River and the numerous hiking trails.

Come enjoy the Flint! An unforgettable river experience is awaiting you at the River Park where you can also rent canoes and kayaks at the Flint River Outpost.


Vann Strawberry Farm
